

2010 WISCONSIN SCHOLASTIC CHESS CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Official State Scholastic Championships!

March 20-21

Gruenhagen Conference Center, UW-Oshkosh

Format: Six sections to choose from! The **Varsity I, Varsity II** and **Varsity III** sections are five person team, team Swiss events with 5 rounds. The **Junior Varsity (K-12), K-8** and **K-5** are individual 6 round Swiss events. In all sections team and individual trophies and medals will be awarded! Special team formation rules apply. Note that the varsity sections are not based on school size but rather strength of team.

Site: Gruenhagen Conference Center, UW-Oshkosh. A dormitory converted into a conference center. Participants may lodge at Gruenhagen for \$35 in a single or double full service room or for \$25.50 in a single or double student service room. Reserve rooms directly with Gruenhagen at 920-424-1106.

Entry Fee: If received by March 13, \$13. If received by March 19 (Noon), \$17. At site is \$22. See the full flyer for the entry form.

Ratings?: While the event is not a US Chess Federation membership required event, USCF ratings will be used for pairing purposes if the player has one. Other ratings not used.

Time Control: Depending on section and day, the time control is either Game in 90 minutes or Game in 60 minutes. See full flyer for details.

Saturday Night Fun: includes a simultaneous exhibition with three time Wisconsin State Champion Bryan Lilly and a bughouse tournament sponsored by Waupaca High School's Chess Club.
