

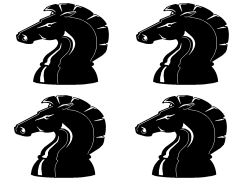

USCF Open K-12 Rated or Unrated; USCF membership req.
USCF U700 K-12 Playing in a Rated section at Nationals? You need 8 rated games in the 6 months before. Get 5 or 6 at Elmwood!

Non-Rated K-6 Great for beginners. Have fun playing for individual and team awards. Minimum entry fee.
Non-Rated K-3

Format:

Indiv/Team Swiss: Unlimited team size. All players play all rounds.

Team Scoring: 2-4 scores count toward school team score.

Open: 5 Rounds, G/45 (45 min./player), **Round 1: 9:00**

U700, K-6, K-3: 6 Rounds, G/30 (30 min./player), **Round 1: 9:30**

Schedule:

Check In: 7:45 – 8:45AM; Late Check-in players start in Rd 2.

Round 1: Open - 9:00AM; U700, K-6, K-3 - 9:30AM

Next Rds. 10 minutes after last game of Previous Round.

Awards: Start after each section finishes; between 3:00-5:00PM
